

Autistic Pride Day 2024

Autistic Pride day is a pride celebration for autistic people held on 18th June every year (Tuesday 18th June 2024). Autistic Pride recognises the importance of pride for autistic people and its role in bringing about positive changes in broader society. The aim of this day is to both raise awareness of autism, and to honour and celebrate the unique strengths and talents of autistic individuals while advocating for acceptance and inclusion.

Autistic Pride Day is represented by the rainbow infinity symbol. This symbol is intended to represent the diversity of autistic people and the infinite possibilities and variations within the autistic community.



In June 2005 an organisation called Aspies for Freedom (AFF) launched the first annual Autistic Pride Day, with events all around the world. This year will mark the 19th annual event.

There are many famous celebrities/public figures who have autism such as Sir Anthony Hopkins, Greta Thunberg, Elon Musk & Daryl Hannah.
